- Elicit requirements in collaboration with Customer's stakeholders, Dawn Health Project Manager, UX Designers and Software Architects/Developers.
- Plan for traceability, requirements lock and verifications with Customers and Dawn Health colleagues.
- Identify opportunities for simplification and better User Experience, reduce inconsistencies.
- Keep Project Members and Customers informed with frequent communication about the state of the Software Project.
- Support planning and documentation of System Test Cases.
